

## FREE Colorectal Cancer Screening Reminders for Patients



The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommends **provider assessment & feedback, and provider reminder and recall systems** to increase colorectal cancer screening (FOBT/FIT, sigmoidoscopy or colonoscopy) for patients 50 to 75 years old, or earlier if patients are at increased risk (i.e., IBS, symptomatic, family history).

Each year, nearly 1,400 Kansans are diagnosed with CRC and more than 500 Kansans die of the disease, making CRC a leading cause of cancer death in the state. CRC can be eliminated if detected early before cancerous polyps have a chance to grow and spread.

Join the Kansas Cancer Partnership to promote CRC education and screening, and reduce the burden of cancer in Kansas!

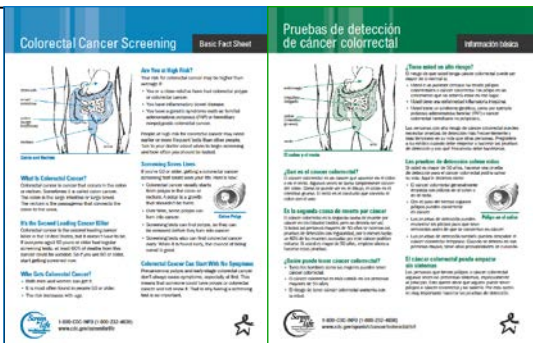
